Chairman Lynn called the meeting to order at 6:40 p.m. in Nevada Room C of the Carson Nugget, 507 N. Carson St., Carson City, NV. The CWSD/Alpine County Joint Powers Board was convened. Roll call was taken and a quorum was determined to be present. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mr. James

<u>Item #5 - Approval of Agenda.</u> Director Penzel made the motion to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was seconded by Director Jardine and unanimously approved by the Board.

Item #6 - Approval of the Board Meeting Minutes from October 19, 2016. There was no meeting in Director Fierro made the motion to approve the Minutes of the Board Meeting on October 19, 2016. The motion was seconded by Director Stodieck and unanimously approved by the Board, with Director Rawson abstaining for not having been at that meeting.

Director Bonkowski requested that Item #14 be removed from the consent agenda for discussion. *Director Schank made the motion to approve the consent agenda, including items #8-13. The motion was seconded by Director Stodieck and unanimously approved by the Board.*

END OF CONSENT AGENDA

<u>Item #14 - Discussion for possible action regarding changes to the CWSD Travel Policy.</u> Director Bonkowski noted an error in the suggested language to be included in the policy. The last sentence should read: "In that case the employee *will* be reimbursed for all work miles driven."

Director Bonkowski made the motion to approve the changes to the CWSD Travel Policy with the corrected language. The motion was seconded by Director Erquiaga and unanimously approved by the Board.

<u>Item #15 - Discussion for possible action regarding a presentation of the FY 2015-16 audit by</u> <u>Kohn & Company.</u> - Beth Farley, partner at Kohn & Company, explained the FY 2015-16 audit. There were no difficulties with the audit nor disagreements with the management. The audit went smoothly and adjustments were made. This was not a single audit. Director Bonkowski asked a question regarding Note 8 regarding pensions. Ms. Kohn reviewed it and explained that this is a requirement that the State asked all public entities to include, but mentioned that the District is not held liability for this pension liability.

Director Schank made the motion to accept the FY 2015-16 audit as presented. The motion was seconded by Director Stodieck and unanimously approved by the Board.

<u>Item #16 - Discussion for possible action regarding selection of the 2017 recipient of the Andy</u> <u>Aldax Watershed Award.</u> - Director Abowd explained that the Administrative Committee had met on November 29 to review the nominations for the 2017 Andy Aldax Watershed Award. Nominees included Rich Wilkinson, Juan Guzman, Steve Lewis, Richard Harvey, and Tod Carlini. After consideration of all the qualified candidates, the committee recommended approval of Juan Guzman, retired Carson City Open Space Department Director, to receive the award. Mr. Guzman received two nominations for the award for serving for many years to the benefit of the Carson River Watershed and continuing to serve actively in the community.

Mr. James commented that it is good to see so many nominations this year. Hopefully some of those who were nominated this year will appear as nominees in the future. Brenda Hunt and Director Lynn told about their experiences with Mr. Guzman.

Director Abowd made the motion to approve Juan Guzman to receive the 2017 Andy Aldax Watershed Award. The motion was seconded by Director Bonkowski and unanimously approved by the Board.

<u>Item #17 - Discussion for possible action regarding selection of CWSD Board officers in 2017.</u> At the 11/29/16 Administrative Committee meeting, the committee reviewed the rotation policy for Board Officers and the various changes expected to occur in the membership of the CWSD Board in 2017 due to new Directors replacing outgoing Directors. Considering those things, the Administrative Committee recommended approval of Karen Abowd as Chair, Carl Erquiaga as Vice Chair, Don Jardine as Treasurer, and Toni Leffler as Secretary.

Director Penzel made the motion to approve Karen Abowd as Chair, Carl Erquiaga as Vice Chair, Don Jardine as Treasurer, and Toni Leffler as Secretary to the CWSD Board for 2017. The motion was seconded by Director Stodieck and unanimously approved by the Board.

<u>Item #18 – Discussion for possible action regarding agreements with counties for BLM</u> <u>Challenge Cost Share Grant.</u> Shane Fryer explained that on p. 127 in the Board package is the agreement with the counties' CWMAs to do the weed work on BLM lands as soon as the NEPA process is complete.

Director Fierro noted that this item was agendized "For Information Only" even though the Board information recommended a motion. Mr. James verified that the item did not require a motion.

No action required on this item; receive and file.

<u>Item #19 – Discussion for possible action regarding hiring R.O. Anderson Engineering to</u> <u>conduct supplemental surveys for the Carson River Floodplain Mapping in Douglas County.</u> Mr. James explained that HDR needs additional information for the floodplain mapping because of land use changes. CWSD would like to have R.O. Anderson Engineering survey additional locations in Douglas County. The total cost of \$2,460 would come out of the FEMA grant.

Director Penzel questioned why the model didn't account for houses that were raised out of the floodplain. Mr. James explained that the processing of the LiDAR data strips out the houses to determine a ground level. Sometimes the land elevation can get lowered, causing depression in the land terrain. The model is showing possible breakouts like on Hwy. 88. R.O. Anderson Engineering will survey these areas. We just want to make sure information is correct.

Director Fierro made the motion to hire R.O. Anderson to survey additional locations in Douglas County. The motion was seconded by Director Abowd and unanimously approved by the Board.

Item #20 - Staff Reports

General Manager - Mr. James reported:

- The legislature starts again in two months. A lot of water bills coming forward. He would like to invite someone from the State Engineer's office to come to the February CWSD Board meeting to explain the water bills. Mr. James will schedule a Legislative Committee meeting as soon as the committee is formed in January.
- FEMA MAS #6 funds the Goni Creek Floodplain Study. Robb Fellows of Carson City says there are a lot more buildings in the Goni floodplain than he thought. Mr. Fellows thought the original survey data would be accurate enough, but there is a need for additional surveying. There is funding available in MAS #6 grant to give to Carson City additional funds for surveying and new model runs.

Brenda Hunt reported that the Watershed Forum is scheduled as a two-day conference on February 22-23, 2017. On 2/21/17, CWSD is working with NDEP and EPA for a tour of the Carson City Mercury Superfund Site from Morgan Mill to Stillwater. There will be a two-and-a-half-hour workshop by EPA about the Mercury sites on 2/22/16, before the Forum begins.

Legal –Mr. Benesch did not have anything specific to report.

Item #14 - Directors' Reports

Director Fierro noted that leaving the CWSD Board is bitter sweet. He's learned a lot and appreciates this Board and staff.

Director Rawson expressed the same sentiments.

Director Lynn stated that he has enjoyed the last eight years on this Board and will miss everyone.

Director Schank thanked those Directors departing the Board. It has been a pleasure to get to know them and work with them. He also thanked staff for all their work.

The rest of the Directors had nothing specific to report but echoed Director Schank's comments.

- Finance Committee Directors Fierro (replaced by Gray), Lynn (replaced by Thayer), Bonkowski, Jardine, and Schank - This committee reviews proposed budget and budget augmentations, funding requests, and requests for potential water rights purchases. The Treasurer serves on this committee. The Finance Committee met one time in 2016.
- 3. Legislative Committee Directors Abowd, Johnson, Lynn (replaced by Thayer), Osborne, Roberts, and Schank This committee would review proposed legislation. (NOTE: This committee does not have an Alpine County representative because it is primarily dealing with Nevada legislation. However, Alpine County representatives are encouraged to bring any California or federal issues to the attention of the General Manager/Board. Also, as a non-voting member of the CWSD Board, Director Osborne's presence on this Board does not violate the six Nevada Directors quorum.) –The Legislative Committee did not meet in 2016 because there was no legislative session but is expected to meet in 2017.
- <u>Regional Water System & Flood Committee</u> Directors Erquiaga, *Fierro* (replaced by Gray), Jardine, Bonkowski, Osborne, Penzel, and Stodieck - This committee focuses on the regional programs, recharge projects, future construction, and water quality. The Regional Water System Committee met once in 2016. (NOTE: This committee does not violate the six Nevada Directors quorum because
