Program Impacts

- Served 30,000 students in 2017;
 3000+ Volunteers
 - 20-25% of all 1st through 6th grade students across NW NV
- 5% more students at SNJ schools score proficient on State exam
- 90% students improved comprehension
- 40% average gain score
