What Does NRCS Do?

- Voluntary
- Financial and technical resources
- Inventory and evaluate Resource Concerns
- Provide alternatives
- Development of a Conservation Plan

Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP)

- Most popular and most frequently utilized conservation program.
- Provides financial assistance to eligible land users to install conservation practices on their farms and ranches.
- Must be a landowner or operator
- Can do cooperative contracts between 2 or more participants to solve problems that cross boundaries







The Inflation Reduction Act (IRA)



- The IRA directs NRCS to use the additional funds specifically for **climate change mitigation**.
- Mitigation activities *reduce greenhouse gas emissions* and improve carbon storage.
- The IRA does not create any new programs it gives NRCS additional funds to expand its existing climate efforts and satisfy unmet demand
- We are currently accepting FY23 applications until **April 28**th

Source Water Protection (SWP)



- The 2018 Farm Bill added a provision providing for the protection of source water through targeted conservation practices.
- Encourages protection of drinking water sources by identifying local priority areas in each state and providing incentives for practices related to water quality and quantity
- Practice examples:
 - Structures for Water Control
 - Nutrient Management
 - Watering Facilities





National Water Quality Initiative (NWQI)


Provides targeted funding in small watersheds to address impaired water bodies through voluntary conservation.

Watersheds:

- Brockliss Slough
- Lower West Fork Carson River
- Town of Gardnerville-East Fork
- Town of Genoa-Carson River


