Governor's Office of Federal Assistance Overview

- ❑ Established on July 1, 2022, with enacting legislation NRS 223.460
- ❑ Office locations in Carson City and Las Vegas
- ❑ Serves as the Single Point of Contact (SPoC) for federal grant applications subject to intergovernmental review.
- ❑ OFA provides a multitude of services for our statewide stakeholders (state agencies, local agencies, tribal governments, and nonprofits) that support their efforts in researching, applying for, receiving, and administering federal grants

Vision

The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance supports our stakeholders in obtaining, increasing, and maximizing federal assistance.

Mission

The Governor's Office of Federal Assistance reduces barriers by providing inclusive, collaborative, comprehensive, and centralized support in obtaining federal dollars for Nevada.



Services and Support Provided

Technical Assistance

- Direct, personal technical assistance for federal grant questions from its stakeholders.
- OFA staff will research and analyze all questions asked and will provide a detailed response, containing information which aligns to the specific regulatory authority requirements.



Services and Support Provided

Grant Training and Education

OFA delivers grant training to all stakeholders, free of charge.

- Specialized One-on-One Training Available

Grant Support Resources

Nevada Grant Manual

OFA provides an in-depth resource manual that contains detailed information on the federal grant process, grant management best practices, and resources, for the grant writer, grant manager, and grant recipient.

Grant Matching Program

OFA administers the Grant Matching Program which provides matching funds for state agencies, local and tribal governments, and nonprofits applying for new federal funding. The program awards matching funds on a first-come, first-served basis to satisfy up to 50% of the required match necessary to receive federal funding awards.

US Digital Response Grant Identification Tool

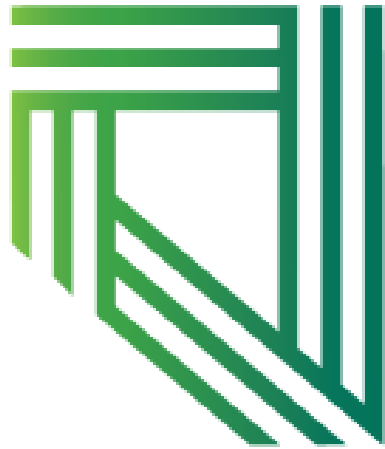

The Nevada Grant Matching Program

General Overview

- *GMP's goal is to increase federal funding to the great State of Nevada!*
- All GMP Resources are located online at ofa.nv.gov [Grant Matching Fund Program \(nv.gov\)](http://ofa.nv.gov/Grant-Matching-Fund-Program)
- The program awards cash grants on a first-come, first-serve basis to **satisfy up to 50% of the required match** necessary to receive federal funding awards
- All efforts to find available funding must have been exhausted
- Applicants applying between March and June of any given year should contact grants@ofa.nv.gov to learn more about the upcoming deadlines due to the Nevada State Fiscal year and Biennial fiscal process
- GMP is for *required* match only. It is not available for subawards or passed-through funds and is provided for the Recipient of the federal opportunity
