



WY 2023 Historic for Snow Water Equivalent




April 1 Snow Courses (squares) and SNOTEL (circles) ranked over the period of record. Note all measurements in the Carson Basin were new records!

- Blue Lakes highest in 105 years by 13" of SWE! (1952 2nd highest)
- Upper Carson Pass highest in 94 years! (Beat
 - 1969 and 1952 by over 8" of SWE)
- Poison Flat highest in 65 years Crushed
 - 1983 record by over 20"! (combined SNOTEL and

Snow Course)








Above: An animation illustrating the enhanced and suppressed convective phases of the MJO as it moves eastward.

- The MJO, or Madden Julian Oscillation may have played a role.
- While ENSO (El Niño Southern Oscillation) is stationary and will last for several seasons or longer, the MJO is an eastward moving cluster of storms in the tropics that circles the planet every 30-60 days on average.
- The MJO can either overlap with and enhance the effects of El Niño, or it can be destructive and work against the atmospheric pattern, as we saw several instances of early this winter.













Snow Water Equivalent (in.)



Monthly Mountain Precipitation













- Pacific moisture feed












Regional Snowpack and Storm Totals









Carson Soil Moisture (From SNOTEL)






Observed Streamflows

Forecast Seasonal Volume (WY2024)



West Fork of Carson April-July Median Forecast


Seasonal (Apr-Jul) Historical Flow for WOOC1






East Fork of Carson April-July Median Forecast

Seasonal (Apr-Jul) Historical Flow for CEMC1


