


History - "Carson River Corridor"



Planning

- 1993 Proposed by a Carson City Board of Supervisor (BOS)
 - 13-member steering committee
 - Theme: public access to River
- 1994 Carson River Workshop
 - Over 100 attendees
- April 7, 1994 BOS adopted A
 Resolution of Support of Planning for
 the Future of the Carson River
 - Led to the creation of the Carson River Advisory Committee.




History -

Planning

- 1996 Passage of Question 18 Quality of Life Initiative
- 1994-2013 Carson River Advisory Committee
- 1996 Carson River Master Plan (CRAC)
- 1996 Carson River Master Plan written
- 2000-2025 land acquisitions in Carson City
 - 11 miles of river corridor protected
 - Approx. 5,000 acres in the river corridor
- 2022 Carson City seeks to update the Carson River Master Plan

Original Goals

- Develop a "Carson River Corridor"
 - Public access
 - Land acquisitions → Open Space program
- ID wildlife conservation opportunities
- Balance recreation with natural/cultural resources conservation
- Minimize impacts to water quality/river health from urbanization
- Environmental education opportunities



Carson River Master Plan (1996) Positive Impacts








Elements identified to add to updated Carson River Master Plan:

- How environmental, natural and cultural resource concerns identified in 1996 plan have been addressed.


Carson River Master Plan Update








Carson River Master Plan Update Next Steps...
